## MILITARY SPECIFICATION

### BUCKLES; AND CLIPS, END, STRAP (FOR BELT, TROUSERS)

This specification is approved for use by all Departments and Agencies of the Department of Defense (DoD).

#### 1. SCOPE

1.1 Scope. This document is applicable to buckles and end clips used with belts worn by personnel of the United States military.

1.2 Classification. This specification covers the following types, classes, subclasses and sizes of buckles and clips.
